Minister Waits Two Hours in A & E after 'Attack.'

'Westminster Vigilante' claims responsibility and says his mission is to ensure Ministers know what real life is like.

In a statement released to the media, the self-styled 'Westminster Vigilante' claims responsibility for organising an 'attack' by jobs on the Minister for Hospitals, John Bupa, on Saturday night.
